

LINCOLN SENIOR MEN'S GOLF LEAGUE
BOARD MEETING MINUTES
MAY 12, 2016

1. Jessen reported that a makeup Fun Day has been scheduled at Tara Hills on Wednesday, September 14.
2. At this time, Holmes Golf Course is still inaccessible because of water over the access road. The Corps of Engineers is not letting water out of the dam until conditions change downstream. It is highly likely that the course will not be open for 18 hole play on Wednesday, May 18, making our schedule starting on both 9's virtually impossible. Alternatives for scheduling League play on Wednesday were examined, and it was determined to attempt to move the matches scheduled to start on Holmes #10 to Pioneers if possible. Tim Rowland has agreed to reserve for us tee times not already scheduled for other players. We will try to work out what we can.
3. Allen reported that City action on recommendations of the Advisory Committee to make the municipal golf program viable are still pending.
4. Using the current Woodland Hills situation (still an extensive standby list) as an example, Jessen reviewed this Fun Day policy: when more than one event is scheduled at the same course during the year, those persons registered for the first event who did not get on the final list for play will be given priority for signing up for the second event. Although no vote was taken, it was generally agreed that this policy should continue to be followed.
5. There was considerable discussion regarding the Sub list format on the website. Conclusion . . . ?
6. Bergman reported that Coordinators have been identified for nearly all the Divisions. When completed, the names and contact information for the Coordinators will be added to the Division Schedules posted on the website at the next revision.
7. Bergman is preparing a document outlining the responsibilities and expectations of the Coordinators which will be posted on the website.

8. There were no more items of business on the agenda; but, as one might expect with such a diverse group of talented folk interested in the best operation of the League, there was considerable more discussion of a wide range of issues. No specific action was taken, but the membership may be assured that the League will benefit from the continued dedication of this group.
