President Bill Allen called the meeting to order at 10am.

Fun Day Signup Procedures: There was considerable discussion pertaining to signup procedures for the six groupings of Fun Days for 2018. For some of the more popular venues such as Iron Horse and Woodland Hills, it was felt that some of the newer members or members not skilled with accessing the website, were being excluded mainly because of their unfamiliarity with the 6:00pm signup deadline. To address this situation it was decided to experiment with a new signup procedure for the three Fun Days scheduled for July, 2018. The modified approach will make all three of these events Mixers and eliminate the timing of one's registration and simply make it possible for everyone to register, with no timing requirement, if they do so prior to the established deadline date. If registrations for any of these three events in July exceed the maximum number of players allowed by the venue, the final participants will be selected with a lottery system methodology to be implemented by the Fun Day Coordinator. The 6 pm registration procedure will remain the same as it was for 2017 for the other five groupings for both the Mixer and U-PIK teams, which may, occasionally, result in a standby list.

Woodland Hills Offer: Woodland Hills has offered all Senior League members the opportunity to purchase VIP membership cards for \$30. There was a motion made and approved to allow President Bill to disseminate the details of this offer to the membership.

Publicity: Greg Bauer has designed an ad and written an article publicizing the Senior League which will appear in the February 24th issue of the Neighborhood Extra. He cautioned the Board that due to the Journal Star's decision to do away with the Neighborhood Extra as a separate insert, and a change in the editor, that it is uncertain whether Fun Day and League results and photographs will continue to be published.

Registration Form for 2018: Veryl Jessen has finalized the form for 2018 which will be included on the League website and utilized at the March 21 Spring meeting.

Rules: The rules for the 2018 season have been posted on the League website.
