Finance Report: The League ended 2016 with a balance of \$10,811.06. All gift certificates have been redeemed. They totaled \$6,289 for the 2016 season.

Spring Meeting Plans: The organizational and membership registration meeting will be held at 10am, March 15th, at the Auld Center. Veryl Jessen circulated a draft copy of the 2017 Registration Form. (Copy Attached). Motion made, seconded and unanimously carried to approve this form and make it available on the League website no later than February 28, 2017.

Fun Days for 2017: A master Fun Day schedule for 2017 consisting of 24 Fun Days and six signup periods was reviewed and discussed. (Copy Attached) All dates have been confirmed. The dates and times for the six registration blocks have been set when members can register via funday@lincolnseniorgolf.com. The first registration date will occur Mar. 28th beginning at 6pm. The final schedule should be available for distribution and publication on the website by March 15th. The first Fun Day for 2017 will be held at Crooked Creek April 12.

Publicity: Greg Bauer circulated a draft of an article including membership and League information to be included in the February 25, 2017 Neighborhood Extra for a fee of \$900. This will include the cost of smaller ads to be run the following two weeks. Positive discussion followed.

Hole Handicap Ratings for White Tees on Lincoln Muni Courses: Larry Honeycutt surfaced a proposal by one of the members to join in a group effort with other Lincoln Muni organizations to work with the City and revise the hole handicap ratings for the four muni courses. After considerable discussion, however, it was the consensus of the Board to decline

this invitation and rather proceed with the Senior League's own study, with the results remaining unique to the Senior League play from the white tees. The ad hoc committee will be meeting on February 16th to proceed with this study, which will consist of evaluating the handicap ratings for each hole for the four muni courses for the white tees on a full 18 hole basis.
