**Rules Changes for 2017:** The flagstick may remain in place for any ball putted on the green.

**Dues for 2017:** No change...\$30 for full member; \$20 for substitutes

**Fun Days:**

Scores not in the money will be posted first.

Six registration periods for 2017; First sign-up opportunity, March 28, 6pm

Will allow no more than four participants for each E mail

The attendees gave unanimous voice approval to allow automatic signups for the President, Fun Day Manager and photographers and their groups

**Hole Handicap Ratings:** Hole handicaps for Mahoney will be left the same as the City hole handicaps for that course. A Board Committee revised hole handicaps from the white tees for Pioneers, Highlands and Holmes. These hole ratings will be used for handicap purposes on the LSMGL scorecards and will differ from the golf course scorecards on some holes. This is due to the variance in the relationship between the white and blue tees. Examples are #7 at Holmes and # 15 at Highlands.

**Substitutes:** Mike Toomey, Sub List Manager, reported that between 10 and 30 subs are needed each week during regular League play. All subs were requested to inform Mike as to how frequently they wished to play and provide him with dates when they would not be available. The subs have been Coded 1 thru 7. A Code 1 sub is willing to play every week, and then Subs with Code designations 2 thru 7 would be available less often. Members were encouraged to check Section VI of the Rules and follow the procedure for notifying the Scorecard preparer.
